## AFC Asia Frontier Fund (Non-US)

Class A – USD – ISIN KYG0133A1004

This fund is managed by Asia Frontier Capital Ltd. (Cayman Islands)

### Objectives and Investment Policy

The investment objective for the AFC Asia Frontier Fund (Non-US) is to achieve long-term capital appreciation by investing in listed equities of companies that have their principal business activities in high-growth Asian frontier markets. The fund focuses primarily on investments in consumer related stocks, financials, and infrastructure.

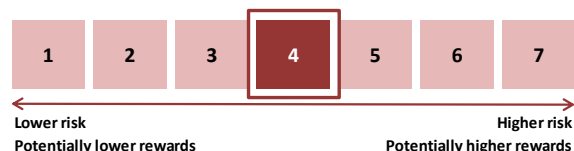
The investment policy focuses on a combination of a top down-bottom up approach with investments being made using a “Value and Growth at Reasonable Price” (GARP) approach. The investment policy has a heavy focus on meeting companies by regular on the ground visits to companies within the fund’s country universe.

This share class has a monthly liquidity with a notice period of 90 calendar days for redemptions.

The fund domicile is Cayman Islands.

The income received from the fund’s investments is accumulated with the result of increasing the value of the shares. For further information on the objectives and investment policy of the fund, please refer to the section “Investment Objectives and Strategy, Investment Restrictions and Terms of Offering” of the current private offering memorandum of the AFC Asia Frontier Fund (Non-US) and its supplement. The benchmark of the fund is: “AFC Adjusted Frontier Asia Index”, which base as of 31<sup>st</sup> May 2017 was: 37% MSCI Frontier Markets Asia Net Total Return USD Index and 63% Karachi Stock Exchange 100 Index in USD. The benchmark is indicated for information purposes only, and the fund manager does not intend to track it. The fund can deviate from this benchmark.

#### What does this indicator mean and what are its limits?

#### Why is the Fund in this specific category?

The fund invests mainly in equity securities of companies located in or doing significant business in Asian frontier markets. Frontier markets have historically been subject to significant price movements, frequently to a greater extent than equity markets globally. As a result, the performance of the Fund can fluctuate considerably over time.

#### Risks materially relevant not adequately captured by the indicator:

**Currency risk:** the risk of loss arising from exchange-rate fluctuations or due to exchange control regulations.

**Frontier markets risk:** the risk related to investing in countries that have less developed political, economic, legal and regulatory systems, and that may be impacted by political/economic instability, lack of liquidity or transparency, or safekeeping issues.

**Liquidity risk:** the risk that arises when adverse market conditions affect the ability to sell assets when necessary. Reduced liquidity may have a negative impact on the price of the assets.

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## Charges

### One-off charges taken before or after you invest

Entry charge: from 0% to 5%  
Exit charge: 0%

### Charges taken from the Fund under certain specific conditions

Performance fee: 10% of NAV appreciation above 3 month USD LIBOR +2% using high water mark.

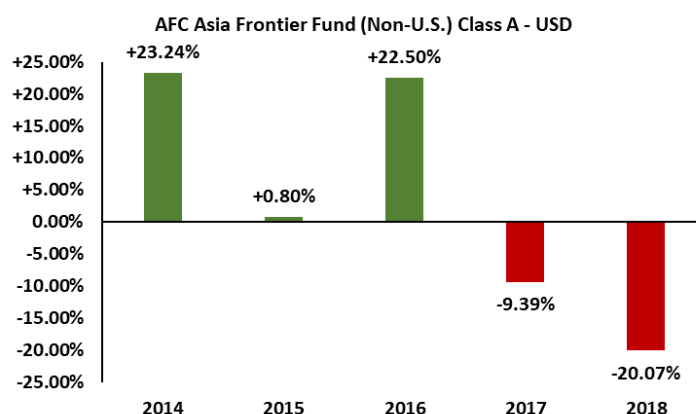
### Charges taken from the Fund over a year

Ongoing charges: 3.92%
